Calumet Synergy Association ("CSA") would like to award three students beginning in post-secondary studies with a CSA Scholarship Excellence Award. CSA would like to recognize those students and emphasize the importance of supporting their contributions to our area.

VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

CSA will grant a one-time Scholarship award in the amount of \$1000 sponsored by EMBER RESOURCES and two CSA scholarships of \$500.00 each for use by that student during their first post-secondary academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible for the Scholarship award, a student must:

- Live in the CSA area (please see the map and descriptor below for the extended boundaries)
- Be entering his or her first year of full-time undergraduate studies leading to a degree, diploma or certificate
- Have demonstrated positive support and service to the community
- Write an essay (minimum of 250 words to a maximum of 500 words) to indicate why you are deserving to receive this Scholarship Award
- Provide a letter of reference from your school principal, a teacher, the guidance counselor, employer or community program leader
- Have confirmation of acceptance from the Registrar's office of the post-secondary institution that you are attending indicating your full-time status

Should you wish to apply for this Scholarship Award, please contact your Guidance Counselor and fill out or complete the following: Application Form, Essay and Letter(s) to be submitted to your Guidance Counselor **prior to June 29, 2024** for submission to CSA Contact – Mrs. Leanne Walton. Alberta Government Transcript of Marks and Proof of Registration submitted directly to Leanne Walton on or before **August 31, 2024**.
