ASAA SCHOLARSHIPS

ASAA MICHAEL VAUGHAN "SPIRIT OF SPORTSMANSHIP" SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000)

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants for the Michael Vaughan Spirit of Sport Scholarship must:

- Be a Grade 12 student at an ASAA member school
- Participate in multiple activities as an athlete (one sport must be an ASAA sport)
- Have applied and been accepted to a qualified postsecondary institution for the upcoming school year.

 Exhibit outstanding character, demonstrating the
- highest level of sportsmanship during their athletic career and serve as a role model for all students at their high school.
- Display evidence in enhancing culture, building community, and providing leadership through their actions with sport.

Application Requirements

Submission of Application Form which includes:

- 1. Outline of involvement in athletics
- 2. Outline how servant leadership has played a role in your athletic career
- 3. Written submission on three questions (max 500 words each):
 - a. What impact has your involvement in school sport had on you and on the school community?
 - b. What impact do you hope to have in the future as you move into adulthood?
 - c. How have you demonstrated the "Spirit of Sport" through your ASAA athletic career?
- 4. Letters of Reference/Support (Maximum 2)
 - a. at least one from a teacher/coach directly involved in your sport, and another as a character reference. Cannot be a family member - must be a school staff member or school coach.
 - b. Letters of reference submitted must provide evidence of participation in sport, personal development, and show evidence of the student displaying positive character traits

PAY IT FORWARD SCHOLARSHIP (\$500)

Scholarship Overview This scholarship is available for grade 12 high school students who contribute back to their school and/or community athletics programs. This may include dedicating their time to coaching, sport administration, officiating, statistics, team management, media coverage, and/or organization of their high school sports team or community sports teams. Scholarship applications will be submitted to the ASAA office for adjudication. There will be one recipient (male or female) selected from each of the eight zones to receive a scholarship (two will be selected from Calgary and Edmonton zones due to significantly higher populations) for a total of 10 x \$500 scholarships awarded on an annual basis.

Eliaibility Requirements

- Applicants must be a current grade 12 high school student scheduled to graduate the same year as the application submission. Higher preference will be given to those who have competed in an ASAA sport throughout their three (3) years of high school;

 The student must be in good standing at their school;
- The student must demonstrate their involvement as a volunteer in grades 10, 11 and 12 in either ASAA or community sports. This may include involvement through roles such as:
 - Coach, Assistant Coach;
 - Official: or
 - Administrative duties such as statistician, team manager, scorekeeping, video technician, publications, media coverage, etc.

Application Requirements

- Submission of Application Form which includes: 1. Submit a minimum of (1) letter of recommendation from the school or community administrator;
 - a. Submit a minimum of (1) letter of confirmation from the school or community association describing the applicant's volunteer experience and duties:
 - 2. Submit a headshot of the applicant; and
- 3. Submit a picture or video clip of the applicant's volunteer efforts (optional)

- Students must be registered at an ASAA member
- Students must participate in ASAA athletic activities

Application Requirements

Submission of Application Form which includes:

- 1. Submit a reference letter from a teacher
- 2. Submit a reference letter from somebody in the sports community
- 3. Submit a resume highlighting your volunteer and sports accomplishments (two pages max)
- 4. Submit an essay exploring what sports and healthy eating mean to you (500 words max)
