**RAP (Registered Apprenticeship Program):** RAP allows students to start apprenticeship training in one of Alberta's 50+ Trades while still in high school. Students will work alongside experienced tradespeople, earn a wage, and gain valuable skills in a chosen trade. Plus, students will simultaneously earn credits towards their high school diploma and towards their Alberta Journeyperson Certification.
